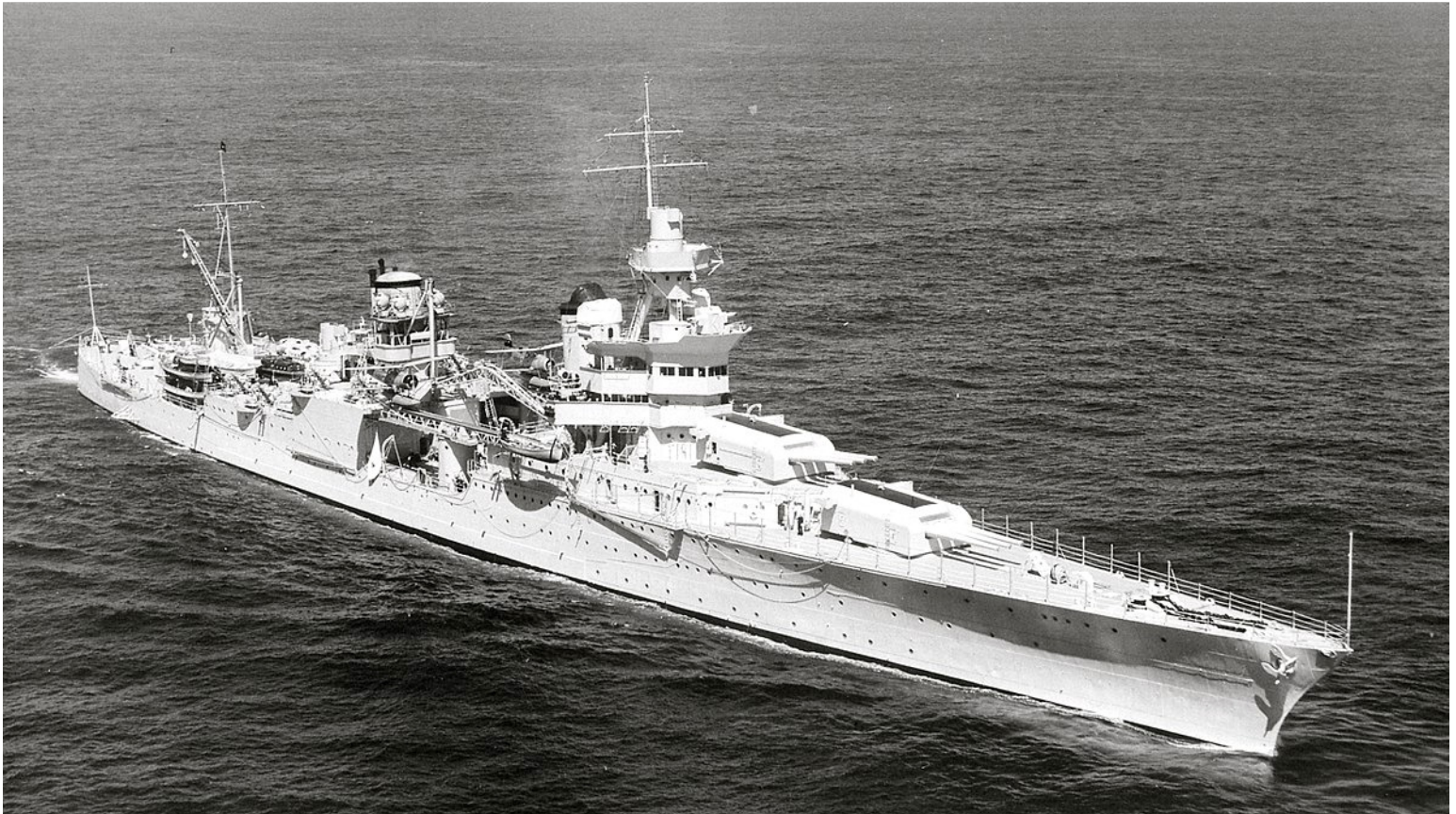




Note from the Chaplain
